

**MC-36-2020 - Request for Proposal for Hiring of National Firm with Experience in Conflict Management Projects to Conduct Endline Evaluation Research for DFID project**  
**Questions & Answers**



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1	The TOR mentions that “FGDs and KIIs should be subsequent to the initial analysis after Household surveys”, while, in light of the short duration required to complete the study, we envision assigning different teams to conduct the survey, KIIs, and FGDs concurrently. Would that be acceptable?	No, the FGD'S and KII's should be subsequent to the initial analysis, the reason for that is to use the information for the initial analysis to inform the KII's and FGD's questions.
2	Is MC going to share with the research agency the project materials (Questionnaire, Screeners, Discussion Guides, Supporting documents)?	Mercy Corps will share all the needed documents such as the report of the baselines and midterm including the questionnaire and the project log-frame.
3	What is the expected LOI for the quantitative survey, KIIs and FGs based on previous waves?	The KII takes between 30-60 min and FGD takes 1-2 hours.
4	Is the research agency responsible for scripting the questionnaire into CAPIs?	Mercy Corps and the research agency will work together to finalize the questionnaire, then the agency will scripting the questionnaire into a data collection tablet/mobile app.
5	Who will be responsible for Enumerators?	The research agency/firm will be responsible for Enumerators.
6	What is the population size for each wave?	For the population of each community please refer to CENSUS 2015.
7	What is the allocated budget for this project?	Mercy Corps can't share the budget of the project.
