Through this notice, Mercy Corps invites legally registered consultancy firms in Kazakhstan to express their interest in participating in a forthcoming Request for Proposal (RFP) process for the **Endline Evaluation of the PATRIP Foundation-funded Water for Peace (W4P)**: Climate Resilient and Peaceful Communities Programme in Kyrgyzstan.

The purpose of the consultancy is to conduct an independent endline evaluation to assess the extent to which the W4P project has achieved its intended objectives, outcomes, and results at project completion, against approved baseline values, logframe targets, and the project's Accountability, Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning Plan (AMEP).

The selected consultancy firm may engage individual experts and field enumerators as part of its team. However, the consultancy firm shall remain fully responsible for quality assurance, data integrity, ethical compliance, contractual obligations, and all final deliverables.

Firms interested in participating in this procurement process are required to complete the attached **Intent to Bid Form** and submit it to gptenders@mercy Corps.org no later than 25 June 2026 (close of business). Please include Tender Reference KAZ 001 in the subject line of your email.

Following the closing date of this Tender Notice, Mercy Corps will issue the Request for Proposal (RFP), including the detailed Scope of Work, to firms that have submitted a completed Intent to Bid Form.
